

Chevron to Build 1MW Solar Farm at Questa Mine

Chevron Mining Inc. (CMI), a subsidiary of Chevron Corp announced that sister company Chevron Technology Ventures (CTV), will build a one megawatt concentrating photovoltaic solar facility on the tailing site of CMI's molybdenum mine in Questa, New Mexico. The facility will include approximately 175 solar panels placed on about 20 acres. The project construction will begin in spring 2010 and conclude by year-end. This will be the largest CPV installation in the U.S> and one of the largest in the world. The electricity produced will be sold to Kit Carson Electric Cooperative through a purchase power agreement. Kit Carson is excited to work with Chevron in this technology demonstration.
