A meeting of the Board of Trustees of Kit Carson Electric Index Cooperative, Inc. (KCEC) was called to order by the President, Mr. Bobby Ortega, on Tuesday, October 29, 2019 at 9:09 a.m. in the Marcelino Martinez Room of the headquarters building of the Cooperative, Taos, New Mexico. overhead lines is less than maintenance for underground lines. Mr. Reves reported that Enervision is conducting a Cost of Service Study for KCEC. He reported that KCEC would be working with The Town of Taos on the number of Air B&B's and short-term rentals. Mr. Reyes reviewed the TEG report from Emissary Group. Mr. R. Martinez reported the Safety Committee met October 10, He reported that KCEC was at 60 days of no lost time accidents and that the Safety Incentive Program was being reviewed on a quarterly basis. discussion, it was moved by Mr. Medina, seconded, by Mr. Jassmann, and unanimously approved, that the CEO report for September 2019 be approved as presented. A copy of the CEO report is included in the Transfer of Documents and is hereby made a part of the minutes of this meeting.

The President reported requests have been received from Capital Credits Estates in the amount of \$8,756.32. It was moved by Mr. to Estates Jassmann, seconded by Mr. Rodarte, and unanimously approved, that payments be made to these Estates. Discussion was held on the process of the Capital Credit allocations.

Mr. Reves suggested changing the date of the November Date Change Board Meeting to Friday, November 22, 2019 to avoid for November having the meeting during the Thanksgiving Holiday Board Meeting week. It was moved by Mr. Rodarte seconded by Mr. Jassmann and unanimously approved the November Board Meeting be held on Friday, November 22, 2019.
