KCEC wants to thank everyone who participated in the 3rd Annual EV Expo on September 25, 2021. Approximately 300 attended the event that included multiple organizations around our communities. KCEC, Renewable Taos, local municipalities and governments had a ribbon-cutting ceremony celebrating the installation of four EV charging stations. The location of the four new EV charging stations is at the Taos Public Library.

The EV Expo included exhibits, guest speakers and a wide assortment of electric products cars, bicycles, scooters, UTV's and motorcycles. Residents were able to test drive and experience the different models of electric vehicles. The exhibits educated residents on the benefits of EV's.
