### **KCEC** is Experiencing Supply Chain Issues

Utilities nationwide are being challenged to acquire necessary electrical equipment in a timely fashion, including KCEC. System upgrades may be delayed amid the ongoing problems associated with global supply chain issues.

With the long lead time and shortage of materials that are used for new construction, new customer connections may be affected and possibly placed on hold. Materials such as transformers, conductors and meters have 40-52 weeks lead times. General Electric is not taking orders for pad-mount transformers, which will put stress on the other manufacturers, which will result in longer delivery times for transformers. Material currently in inventory is being used for outages and emergencies for existing customers as needed. New construction is being prioritized on a case-by-case basis.
