With Winter approaching, KCI had a great year with all the underground projects we completed in 2023. It was a tremendous year for Kit Carson Internet and we could not have done it without our amazing customers, dedicated contractors, and wonderful and hard-working employees.

That said, it is time in the mountainous location to stop all underground construction for fiber optic installations. We will resume where we left off in the springtime.

KCI has created a spring folder that will be prepared during the Winter and ready and available for the contractors once we can commence with underground construction. We ask and thank you for your patience at this time. Aerial construction and maintenance will continue during the winter months.

Winter weather is upon us. Here are some safety tips to ensure a prompt delivery.

If there is a winter storm in the forecast and you are not already on our Keep Full program, check the percentage of propane in the tank. Please call to schedule your delivery if the gauge is between 30-40 percent. Not on Keep Full status; call the office today to be added to the route.

Remove snow from the tank and the nearby surrounding area. Use a broom or your hand to clear the snow from the regulator. DO NOT kick or hit tank parts, as this could cause a leak. If a leak is suspected, shut the tank off and contact the office. Ensure all adults in the home know how to shut off the tank. If you need assistance, we are happy to help.

If the propane tank is located inside a fenced area, clear a path and make sure the gates are not locked. If there is a lock on the gate, ensure the code has been provided to the office or someone over 18 is home to unlock the gate.

If the tank is underground, ensure the area is clear and accessible to the delivery driver. If the tank is not accessible, the delivery will be rescheduled.

You should never store an outdoor propane cylinder indoors. Cylinders should be stored in a proper vented area. KCP services the requalification of outdated cylinders. Please call KCP offices for more information.
