Message from the CEO

KCEC Forest Fire Mitigation Update

Taos, New Mexico-Kit Carson Electric Cooperative (KCEC) wants to keep its members informed about its ongoing forest fire mitigation efforts in the area it serves. After analyzing the data and considering the significant amount of precipitation in the region, KCEC is resuming normal operations for all its protective devices. The cooperative will systematically proceed with its tree trimming and maintenance program while closely monitoring the weather to take necessary actions.

KCEC's ongoing tree trimming and maintenance are top priorities as we move into the harsh winter months. KCEC crews are working diligently to reduce service interruptions by inspecting and tightening electric and internet infrastructure and patrolling and monitoring electric and fiber optic lines.

KCEC crews have cut and maintained the following areas:

- Upper Red River
- Taos Canyon
- Rockwall to Tres Ritos
- Idlewild
- Vallecitos
- La Madera
- Black Lake
- Cabresto Canyon

KCEC crews have strategically worked in these high-exposure areas identified through satellite imagery-assisted applications and internal KCEC operations.

KCEC would like to inform its members that the annual substation maintenance schedule is set for the month of September. During this period, our crews will perform preventive maintenance on all substations within the service area. Please be aware that unforeseen circumstances may arise, potentially extending the duration of the maintenance. This includes maintenance on substations that may not directly affect members. There may be minimal impact on internet services as well.

KCEC wants to thank members, businesses and organizations for their patience and assistance during the dangerously high heat season. KCEC understands the importance of reducing extreme catastrophes in its area and is proactively working to ensure our members have critical services.

Kit Carson Propane

Our existing customer sales have ended. If you have not received your delivery, do not worry, the price is locked in. Due to the high volume of sales orders, deliveries are running longer than expected. Please be patient as we complete the remaining deliveries.

At Kit Carson Propane, we are delighted to have you as part of our family and we want to show our appreciation. Spread the word to everyone: friends, neighbors, and family about Kit Carson Propane, and receive a \$50 discount off your bill for every successful referral. All they have to do is include your information when applying. The best part is that there's no limit on referrals, so the more successful referrals, the more dollars off your bill.

Leak tests are a crucial part of our service, ensuring your safety and peace of mind. They are required when the service has been interrupted, which means the flow of gas has been stopped. Kit Carson Propane will perform a leak test for an out-of-gas situation, a tank that has been shut off, or disconnected. If a leak is detected, the tank will be shut off until the leak has been repaired. If the customer has a 'Will Call' account and runs out of gas, causing an interruption in service, a \$75.00 leak test fee will apply. To prevent an out-of-gas service fee, make sure to check your gauge and place an order when the tank is at 20%. If you smell propane and suspect a leak, shut off the tank and contact the office.

We understand that managing propane costs can be challenging. That's why we offer flexible payment options. Ask about our Neighbors Helping Neighbors program, budget billing, and flexible payment plans. Call the office for more details.
