Message from the CEO

Kit Carson Electric Cooperative Capital Credits Information to Members

This month, on the front of your bill, there is a capital credit allocation amount for the year 2021. This amount is not subtracted from your amount due since it is an allocation. Your December 2024 and January 2025 electric bills will reflect allocations for 2022 and 2023. This notice is sent to each member of the Cooperative in accordance with the provisions of Article 7, Section 2 of the Bylaws. One of the benefits of being a member-owner of an electric cooperative is sharing in the margins (profits) in proportion to the member's purchases of electric energy during the year. Utilities other than cooperatives cannot offer their users a share of the profits.

Please note that capital credits are retired when the Board of Trustees determines the financial condition of the Cooperative will not be impaired or may be used for expenses such as wildfire mitigation, which are deemed more critical. If a Cooperative member is deceased, the representative of the estate should contact Kit Carson Electric Cooperative regarding possible refund of capital credits.

The amount on this statement cannot be deducted from your current bill. Please keep Kit Carson Electric Cooperative informed of your current address for future correspondence.



KCEC Capital Credits



Capital credits represent a member's share of the coop's margins during the time they have membership.

In years that KCEC earns positive margins, you are allocated your portion of the margins based on the amount of electric services purchased for that year.

The 2021 allocation is reflected on your electric bill. The amount is not deducted from your current bill.

Kit Carson Propane

If there is a winter storm in the forecast and you are not already on our Keep Full program, check the percentage of propane in the tank. If the gauge is between 30-40 percent, please call to schedule your delivery. Not taking advantage of our Keep Full program, call the office today to be added to the route.

Did you know we offer an after-hours service? For a fee, a propane driver will deliver propane after regular business hours. Members pay \$125.00, and Non-Members pay \$150.00.

If the propane tank is located inside a fenced area, clear a path and make sure the gates are not locked. If the gate is locked, make sure the code has been provided to the office or someone over the age of 18 is home to unlock it

If the tank is underground, ensure the area is clear and accessible to the delivery driver. If the tank is not free of debris, the delivery driver may be unable to access the tank, and the delivery will be rescheduled.

Flexible payment options are available. Ask about our Neighbors Helping Neighbors program. Call the office for more details. Kit Carson Propane cares about your safety. If you have any concerns, please do not hesitate to contact our office.
